

REAL ESTATE SECTOR SEES GROWTH POTENTIAL IN POONAMALLEE.



Poonamallee seems to be the next big IT highway in the making in Chennai. A lot of realtors are looking at developing IT parks in Poonamallee. Real estate companies are keen on building office spaces to cater to IT firms. This is due to the announcement of the metro rail corridor that would connect Poonamallee to the rest of the city.

As an added advantage, the Mount-Poonamallee stretch also has great groundwater supply. The possibility of a second airport at Parandur and the proposed bus mofussil terminus at Thirumazhisai will only result in further development of the area. With all these developments happening around Poonamallee, the area is expected to grow exponentially in the future.

Foxconn is a Taiwanese electronics manufacturer that manufactures iPhones. Apple's iPhone XR is made at their Sriperumbudur plant, near Chennai. The Taiwanese manufacturer is planning on investing \$1 Billion to establish a factory in Sriperumbudur, which will happen over a period of 3 years. The iPhone models manufactured by Foxconn in China will be manufactured in their Sriperumbudur plant in the future. This change is seen as Apple's move to quietly move its production out of China. The expansion will generate almost 6,000 jobs at the Sriperumbudur plant and will boost the value of the localities around Sriperumbudur.
